CHOLON WORK.

Moved that Mr. Quoc spend three months during the Summer with Mr. Chue, to assist in the Chinese work at Cholon. Carried.

MUSIC TYPE.

Moved that Mr. Cadman be authorized to buy sufficient music type to print Annamese and Cambodian Hymn Books. Carried.

BLOCKING PRESS. Moved that Mr. Cadman be authorized to buy a gold blocking press when funds permit. Carried.
