CHINESE WORK.

Owing to the present Chinese political situation, we recommend that the Chairman write the Chairman of the South China Executive Committee asking that the Chinese work in Indo-China be separated entirely from the work in China and be completely under the control of the Indo-China Conference. Carried.

DROPPED ALLOWANCE.

In response to Mr. Snead's letter of January 9th, moved that we send out money for the Native preachers' N^o 12 allowance, and that the local churches make up this shortage. Carried.

ALLOCATIONS.

Moved that Mr. Stebbins take charge of Cantho and Longxuyen, and Mr. Hammond be in charge of Chaudoc. Carried.

AUTOS.

Moved that Mr. Stebbins have the use of the Chaudoc automobile; that the second car be used in Tourane, and the third one in Pnom-Penh. Carried.

SADEC PROPERTY.

Moved that the Conference include in its Letter of Appeal a reiteration of the request for an appropriation build a house in Sadeo. Carried.

CHOLON WORK.

Moved that Mr. Quoc spend three months during the Summer with Mr. Chue, to assist in the Chinese work at Cholon. Carried.

MUSIC TYPE.

Moved that Mr. Cadman be authorized to buy sufficient music type to print Annamese and Cambodian Hymn Books. Carried.

BLOCKING PRESS.

Moved that Mr. Cadman be authorized to buy a gold blocking press when funds permit. Carried.

LITERATURE.

Moved that the Press be authorized to print 1000 ROMANS by Rev. R. A. Jaffray. Carried.

PRAYER CALENDAR.

Moved that we ask the Press to print a revised catalogue following the action of last Conference, and also to print the Prayer Calendar for 1926. Carried.
