INFORMATION REGARDING CHURCHES SECURED APRIL 17, 1927 FROM MR. JEFFREY AND  
THE PASTOR

---

Mythe - entered October 1923 by Mr. Smith and Thay Tuan; January 1924 by Mr. Ferry. At the end of 1924 the church had two deacons. Thay ~~Pang~~ <sup>Long</sup> 1925 and Thay Thai 1926-27 were pastor evangelists in Mythe. Thay Long became regular ordained pastor of Mythe church July 1927.

Membership 580. Seven deacons, five deaconesses.

Church offerings amount to \$800 per month.

Church building erected 1926-27, paid for by the members, dedicated February 1927, cost \$3000.

Land is leased for fifteen years, rental of \$60 per year.

Bentre - opened June 1924, Thay Thong and Thay Dang colporter evangelists during 1924.

Membership 420; 74 baptized by Mr. Jeffrey April 16, 1927.

Church building is an Amamese house purchased by the congregation at a cost of \$500.

Church organized 1924.

Eight deacons, three deaconesses.

Monthly offerings about \$60.

Gocong - opened in November 1924.

Membership 80, four deacons, one deaconess.

Offerings: 1st Mo. \$13; 2nd Mo. \$19; 3rd Mo. \$14; 4th Mo. \$13;  
5th Mo. \$10; 6th Mo. \$14. The offering on April 17, 1927 when  
Mr. Jeffery and Mr. Snead were present - \$10.67.

Mythe church helps Gocong church less than \$10 per month.
