

MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
OF THE CHRISTIAN AND MISSIONARY ALLIANCE,
INDO-CHINA.
TOURANE, MAY 8th, 1926.

- MEMBERS. Messrs. Irwin, Stebbins, R.M. Jackson, Ellison and Olsen, Mr. Irwin presided.
- SECRETARY. Mr. J. D. Olsen was elected secretary.
- Mr. TE. Moved that the resignation of Nguyen Van Te be accepted. Carried.
- PRINTING OF Moved that we print in Chu-mon the Gospel Catechism, "Den Cung Duc Chua Jesus", "Minh-Tam", and "Tich-ta Qui-Chanh". Carried.
- MR. NGA AND MR. TRAM. Moved that Mr. Nga be transferred to Chaudoc and Mr. Tram to Long Xuyen. Carried.
- BATTAMBANG AND PURSAT. Moved that the native evangelist at Pnompenh make regular visits to the Annamese work at Battambang and at Pursat. Carried.
- MR. TU. Moved that Mr. Tu be employed as a Mission colporteur (Thay Ban Sach Bon-Hoi) to assist Thay Do at An-Thai-Dong, his salary to be 29.00 per month; all receipts for books sold to be applied to his salary. Carried.
- QUANG NGAI. Moved that if an opportunity presents itself an outstation be opened at Quang-Ngai, Annam. Carried.
- RECALCIMINING Saigon House. Moved that Mr. Stebbins be authorized to recalcimine the Saigon House and to repaint the woodwork. Carried.
- RECALCIMINING BATTAMBANG HOUSE. Moved that Mr. Ellison be authorized to recalcimine the exterior of the Battambang house. Carried.
- RECALCIMINING TOURANE HOUSE. Moved that the Committee ratify the expenditure for recalcimining the Mission buildings in Tourane. Carried.
- GATE FOR SAIGON PROPERTY. Moved that the Committee ratify the expenditure of \$23.00 for a new gate the Saigon property. Carried.
- ALTERATION IN TOURANE, HOUSE. Moved that the Committee ratify the expenditure of \$92.82 for alteration in the Tourane Mission House no. 3, in order to accommodate Mr. and Mrs. Travis. Carried.
- ELECTRIC LIGHT IN BIBLE SCHOOL. Moved that the Committee ratify the expenditure of \$32.13 for repairing the electric light fixtures in the Bible School. Carried.
- TOURANE GARAGE. Moved that the Committee ratify the expenditure of \$66.00 for repairs on Mission garage in Tourane. Carried.
- ALTERATIONS IN MISSION HOUSE. Moved that the Committee ratify the expenditure of \$100.00 for alterations in the Mission dwelling house in Pnompenh in order to accommodate Mr. and Mrs. Peterson. Carried.

CALCIMINING
HANOI HOUSE.

Moved that Mr. Jackson be authorized to recalciming the interior of the Hanoi Mission House, and paint the woodwork both inside and outside when funds permit. Carried.

COLPORTEUR
HANOI DISTRICT.

Moved that Mr. Jackson be authorized to employ a Mission colporteur to be used in the Hanoi country district, salary to be not more than \$10.00 per month. Carried.

PNOMPENH OUT-
STATIONS.

Moved that Mr. Hammond be authorized to open three new outstations in the district of Pnompenh when funds permit. Carried.

HOUSES FOR BAT-
TAMBANG BIBLE-
SCHOOL.

Moved that Mr. Ellison be authorized to build native house on Battambang property to be used for the Bible School students and for the Cambodian native workers. Carried.

CANTHO. RESIDENCE.

Moved that the Committee ratify Mr. Stebbins' action in renting an apartment in Cantho at \$17.00 per month, to take the place of the former missionary residence there, Carried.

BIBLE SCHOOL

Moved that we authorize Mr. Olsen to subsidize the School secretary to the extent of \$10.00 per month, Carried.

MR. XUONG.

Moved that we transfer Mr. Xuong, the Mission colporteur at Tri-Ton, to Takeo, Cambodia. Carried.
