Dear Mr. Jeffrey

Your telegram re. Luoi's brother came last night & I immediately paid a visit of enquiry. He had been taken to Hospital with very high fever and died there at 1 o'clock yesterday afternoon (Monday). I enquired whether they had wired news of death & they said no. I told them they should have done so. & they said they would. However I did not trust them & so Mr. C. took telegram to post office at 10 p.m., just before closing, so Mr. Luoi will know today.

I enquired as to whether Mr. Luoi was needed in any way - & his nephew & brother's employer said he was not. The funeral is at 10.30 this morning. I am sorry I cannot go as I have a bad cold & cough & only go out when absolutely obliged. I will send Mr. Thai so he can write particulars to Mr. Luoi.

I would like to know just what standing Luoi & Le' got in the exam, therefore will you be so kind as to send in next letter?
