Just a few lines to enclose bill for the expenses of Mr. Tiep from Hanoi to Tourane. These amount to \$20.77.

There is a strong probability of a Mr. Té attending the Bible School. He is a very fine young man who is at present helping Mr. Soulier, being brought to the LORD by the young man I loaned Mr. Soulier. He is married and his wife appeals to me as a very fine woman also who has possibilities above the usual. Mr. Te writes splendid French and has already a good grasp of the Gospel through his lessons with Mr. Soulier in French. However he says he prefers to study in Annamite as he can make faster progress. He has a good personality. Will write more later when the matter is decided. Also there is one of our own Christians, a Mr. Thong baptized in Tourane two years ago. He is developing very nicely and has the possibility of a good worker.

We appreciate your difficulties this year in the school and are trusting GOD to give you the necessary wisdom, and also ~~the~~ give you richer and fuller experiences of HIS LOVE and GRACE. With kindest regards,
