Dear Mr. Jeffrey,

Many thanks for the prompt sending of the mss. which arrived safely in due course. Just a reminder of the few lines I asked you to write for the present "Call," regarding the changing of chairmen. Also will you kindly remind Mr. Pruett of his article regarding spiritual side of conference. We should now be getting out the "Call" but are delayed because of the lack of these two items.

Another important matter is that of Mr. Thuy being spared from Hanoi to attend school in Tourane. I have prayed much about him and his future. Although he took sides against myself and the mission early last year, yet I feel that he was not to blame and our duty is to do our best by him. As we expect to return home as soon as the Bible is finished, now seems to be the opportune time to help him.

I have spoken to him about going to school and explained how that very soon he will be but a back number, as the policy is that all colporters shall have Bible training. Thus he is willing to attend school in Tourane if the way is opened. I have therefore spoken to Martin who sees Thuy's urgent need of more training and progress spiritually. I have suggested that Mr. Thuy pay all his own expenses coming and going and living in school, but that the Bible Society continue to pay his salary as usual. I have promised to look after Thuy's work for the time he is in school. Martin seems very willing for this.

Now as to the time Mr. Thuy can be at school. His yearly accounts should be through by the end of November. Then he could go to Tourane and stay for say ~~six months~~ five months, returning in time to make up his half-yearly accounts. During this time I would just keep a journal system of book-keeping for the Bible Society with the idea of his coming back to fill in the books of the Bible Society. It is possible that this time may conflict with examinations. Therefore will you kindly write me at once regarding this matter so that matters can be arranged between us.

Trusting that you fully understand this matter and that you will write at once regarding it, with kindest regards, in which Mrs. Cadman joins with me,
