ANNAMESE LANGUAGE COURSE

1st Year

1st Term of Four Months.

1. Study and practice of tones and pronunciations in "Syllabaire Annamite."
2. First three lessons in "Elements de Grammaire Annamite".
3. Memorize the Lord's Prayer.

Note: The first three weeks of the term should be spent in learning the tones and pronunciations: during the rest of the term, at least one hour a day should be used in reviewing and practicing the tones.

2nd Term of Four Months.

1. Finish the Study of "Elements de Grammaire Annamite".
2. Practice writing short sentences, and at the end of each month student should send in to the examiner ten sentences, not corrected by teacher.
3. Asking and answering questions using vocabulary already learned in the "E. de G.D."
4. Practice writing from teacher's dictation.
5. Study the Gospel of Mark.
6. Conversation with teacher and others.

3rd Term of Four Months.

1. Study the Gospel of John.
2. Study "Gospel Catechism".
3. Practice telling short Bible stories, and be specially prepared to tell the story of Creation, Christmas story, and the story of the Samaritan woman.
4. Translate the Sermon on the Mount from English into Annamese and vice versa.
5. Prepare and tell short Gospel messages.
6. Conversation with teacher and others.

2nd year

First term of Six Months.

1. Study the Book of Acts.
2. Study the first part of the "Manuel de Conversation Francaise Annamite."
3. Commit to memory 20 Scripture passages on Salvation.
4. Prepare and write in full, sermons (own composition), at least one each month, and send them in to examiner to be corrected.
5. Study Luan-ly
6. Personal work with inquirers and visitation work.

Second Term of Six Months.

1. Study the second half of the "Manuel de Conversation Francaise Annamite."
2. Study "Chuyen Doi Xua.
3. Continue to prepare and give Gospel messages.
4. Study Romans, Ephesians and Hebrews.

3rd year.

One term of Twelve Months

1. Study Van-Chuong Thi-Phu Annam (Published in Hongkong)
2. Finish the New Testament, and the Old Testament up to Joshua.
3. Study a good Annamese History: suggested, "Vist-Nam Su-Luoc."

Note: Examinations to be taken at the end of each term.
