REPORT OF DEPUTATIONAL TRIP

January to July 1927

FRENCH INDO CHINA

To the President and Board of Managers of The Christian and Missionary Alliance.

"And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus."

With this testimony which God made preciously real throughout the trip, we desire to give praise to God and express our gratitude to the Board for the privilege of sharing in this full gospel missionary ministry through the visitation to the fields as appointed by the Board in January.

Throughout the trip of over 25,000 miles the Lord graciously blessed and kept. It was a joy to have fellowship with the missionaries on seven fields, either in port cities or in the stations of their fields, and to see something of what God is doing in many sections of the work and catch a glimpse of new fields which present opportunity and responsibility to the Christian and Missionary Alliance for immediate evangelistic effort.

French Indo China received the larger portion of our time and attention and your representative was enabled to devote ten weeks to a careful and somewhat detailed study of the work in that field. Besides attending the Annamese and Missionary Conferences and Executive Committee meetings, a visit was made to every station and church in the field, and nearly every outstation received a brief visit. In all forty-five cities and towns, in which the Alliance has ministry, in Tonkin, Annam, Cochin China and Cambodia, were visited. Throughout the more than 6000 kilometers of travel in automobiles, the Lord graciously blessed and protected us from any ill effect of the climate and from accident and harm. Praise His Name!

The results of the preaching of the Gospel in French Indo China cause one to exclaim in fulness of joy, "What hath God wrought?" Yet as the field is studied and the millions of souls who have yet never heard of Christ are considered, one views with great solemnity the task which lies ahead and we are moved to pray, plead and prepare for a very definite manifesting of God's presence in revival power throughout all parts of the field.

Besides giving a brief survey of the field in its five sections, this report deals with several special topics of considerable importance to the work of the Mission.

Despite recent official proclamations against the work in the Faifoo districts, the workers are faithfully carrying on in the name of Christ. Mr. Jeffrey adds in his last letter: "We had a wonderful time at Faifoo last Sunday (July 10th) with a very large attendance."

This introduction to the report will close with a brief quotation from Mr. Jeffrey's letter in which he says: "The Lord continues to add His blessing in our work. The opposition continues to be strong but we know that victory is ours in Christ." And with it an earnest appeal for prevailing prayer for the work and the workers in every part of the field.
