Becki, the oldest daughter is married to Dr. David Thompson, whose parents Ed and Ruth Thompson were killed at TET 1968 during the fighting at Banmethuot. Dr. and Mrs. Thompson will leave in September for France and later Gabon, Africa where they will serve as medical missionaries.

DR. AND MRS. RICHARD PHILLIPS

Dr. and Mrs. Phillips are linguists (his Ph.D. is from Cornell University) whose principal ministry at Banmethuot has been work on Mnong literature and Bible translation. Dr. Phillips is the son of China missionaries; Lillian Amstutz Phillips is the daughter of C&MA missionaries to India. Although classmates at St. Paul Bible College ('54), they did not marry until they were in Viet Nam as missionaries. They have 4 children.

REV. AND MRS. NORMAN JOHNSON childe w/he with in Ham'lt, outerio

Natives of Hamilton, Ontario (Canada) 'Norman and Joan Johnson have been in Viet Nam since 1971. Their two children, Douglas and Patricia, both teenagers, joined their grandparents in Canada after the completion of their school year in Penang, Malaysia.

Much of the Johnson's time in Viet Nam has been occupied in language study. More recently they have been active in ministries among the Raday tribespeople.

Mr. Johnson, after graduation from McMaster University, spent several years as a school teacher before pursuing a divinity degree at Wheaton College in Illinois. Mrs. Joan (Barton) Johnson is a nurse.
