

A GRATEFUL TESTIMONY.

I had come to the Okoboji Conference that summer of 1946 with a great burden on my heart for Vietnam. The message of Salvation through Christ alone was burning in my soul. I must make Him known to the desperately needy millions of that land without delay. But how? I had nothing, but I believed God had what I needed and would answer the cry of my heart.

Realizing the importance of the printed page, I had been praying for quantities of paper, ink, a translator and funds. Dr Don Falkenberg of the Bible Meditation League, now Bible Literature International, was also one of the speakers at the Okoboji Conference that year. To my great joy God led him to take on the support of a translator, the cost of a mimeograph machine and all the paper and ink I would need.

Pastor Doan van Mieng, the president of the Vietnamese Evangelical Church, in a recent letter, reminded us again of the great blessing he received from the precious Bible Commentaries and ~~the~~ other Gospel literature Bible Meditation League enabled us to send to all the Vietnamese churches between 1947 and 1955. He says that it meant everything to the entire Church at that time. He still has the Psalms by Dr A.B.Simpson and a book on Prophecy by Dr H.L.Turner.

The popular type periodical Rang-Dong (Dawn) first published in 1947, has continued to appear monthly through funds supplied by B.L.I. Since January 1967, B.L.I. has published 44,000 copies of this magazine each month for distribution among the men in the Vietnamese Armed Forces, prisoners of war, refugees and others.

We are deeply grateful also for the friends who have continued to make it possible for us to print or purchase all the gospel portions, booklets and other literature needed for work in military Induction Centers, hospitals, prisoners of war and refugee camps etcetera. Bibles and Gospel literature have been placed in bookrooms and pagodas all through South Vietnam. Thousands have confessed faith in Christ as a result. To God be all the glory.
