Received your letter dated December 17th and was indeed very glad to hear from you again. I suppose you think that we people here in Mytho have forgotten all about you in Tourane. Since coming back from Conference we have been kept very busy with baptisms, funerals and weddings. Since Conference I have baptised over 70 people this makes our church a total of 170 members. There are about two hundred more waiting to be baptised as soon as I can get to them.

The Lord is surely blessing us here in Mytho and we surely want to thank and praise the Lord for it. During the month of November 120 people prayed, so you can see how happy we are, wouldn't you be happy also.

I have received the roll of silk that you sent me O.K and thank you very much for the sending of same as I have been waiting for it a long time.
